Student Presentations- Honoring the Devas 10-C



Transformational Steps:

1)Develop 3 ways to honour the devas-with 3 essential oil and process assignments. (Honor the devas and leave a legacy for other students with the college). Think of something that will translate to us keeping in the e-course.

2) Fine tune and edit your creations.

3) Hand in the assignment.

4) Check out other student creations.

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Presentations 1 & 2



Represent 2 oils and one topic you have covered this term and bring them back to present to the class, in a creative way- for a total of 3 presentations.

Purpose: To deepen your understanding of 2 plants and one topic. To learn to work deeply with these plants. To produce something tangible from the relationship. To teach others about these plants.

Aromatherapy Assignment Participation is Required for Certification. Due before completing the course.

You will be asked to do a presentation to send it to the instructors. It can be a video, but may also be in the form of a pdf, audio, drawings, stories etc. We have a range of student presentations in this course that were all acceptable. Presentations 1 & 2- Choose 2 most important or appealing oils in your assigned oil family.



For each essential oil, contemplate:

Why is this oil important? How is it used? What are its main qualities? What distinguishes it from other oils in its family? What are the cautions? How do you feel about it? How do you, or might you, use it? How do you present this information in a creative way?

Presentation 3-

Then for the third presentation, choose another topic discussed in aromatherapy advanced, that was meaningful to you. It might be skin care, medical, cosmetic making, psycho aroma- and do one of your presentations around this idea. Develop it in a way that appeals to you. This will be your third presentation.

Presentations will take about 7-10 minutes each for a total of 20-30 minutes per individual presenter. Use a selection of techniques to relay what you know about the oils and the topics covered in class.

Try different presentation methods for your different topics. For example: if you are doing the Rutaceae family, you may write a poem for orange and a song for neroli or a practical demonstration on how to make a massage oil. Or you might try a meditation for lantana, a drawing for sandalwood or elaborate on how to use hydrosols for skin care. Anything creative goes!



Use your imagination and have fun. Anything from puppet shows, plays, songs, food creation, stories etc. will be loved.


