Introduction

I have loved tarot, ever since Bob McDevitt introduced me to the Rider Deck, at age 13. The mesmerizing characters and the bright colors made my sense of wonder rise, as I glimpsed into future possibilities through symbols. I bought many sets of tarot after that and was always delighted by the imagery and sense of possibility the decks evoked. I found the Mother Peace when I was in my mid twenties and as I flipped through the cards and write ups of the goddess, I knew the story being told was one of a deeper, older truth, than my history books had revealed.

I have been a teacher of metaphysics and alternative therapies for over 25 years. The goddess keeps coming back to me in many ways and forms. I have had the privilege of teaching courses, writing books and making aromatic blends, all highlighting her many aspects.

However, this deck is comprised of both gods and goddesses. Each of these guides brings insights, blessings and meaning. They represent thousands of years of tradition and collective unconscious patterns.

Using The Healing Goddess Oracle cards helps us find out 'who is showing up', on that day, week or year of our lives and tap into what their message might be.

Attuning to which archetypal teacher is present makes life lessons easier and more fun.

In this deck, the Gods and Goddesses are not paired with the Tarot figures in a conventional manner. Yet, each of the beings adds some new energy and perspective to traditional placements. Greek Gods and Goddesses represent the major arcana, in the first 22 cards.

There are some alterations to the names of the classical major arcana, as the Celestial teachers bring in a slightly different energy- for example, Death is renamed the Crossroads, Judgment is referred to as Wise Response.

The remainder of the oracle cards (non major arcana) represents deities from diverse traditions, plus a couple of magical teachers, that are not technically Gods or Goddesses. Instead of using the classical minor arcana, Shamans, Mavens and Magi inhabit this deck. The common suits of cups, swords, wands and pentacles, date back to an even older origin. The four elements, where all life comes from preceded the suits. Water represents cups and emotion, earth carries the abundant and material, pentacle energy, air is equivalent to swords and the intellect and fire like wands, is a suit of spirit.

The Shamans represent the first level of accomplishment. The Mavens and Magi are both masters of the elements and skills they represent. The deck has 34 cards in total. Please use your own intuition and insight to add to what each of the Gods or Goddesses is saying to you, when you consult the oracle.

Layouts and Spreads

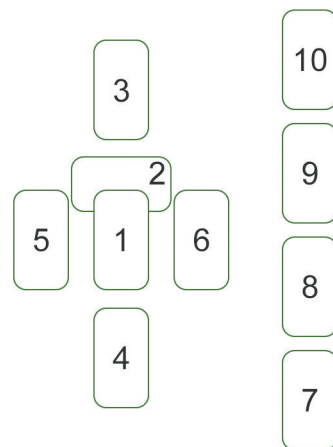
There are a plethora of wonderful spreads possible. I will suggest three that I have found most accessible. If you have other spreads you prefer, use them.

The one card draw - Ask a question and draw a card to give insight around the answer.

The 3 card draw - the first card represents past events, the second is the present moment and the third gives context about the future.

The Celtic Cross:

1. The Present or General Sky
2. The Challenge - What's Crossing you
3. The Distant Past
4. Recent Past (What's beneath you)
5. What's beside you, or a Possible Good Outcome
6. Immediate Future
7. Inner Feelings
8. External Influences
9. Hopes and Fears
10. Final Outcome.



When using the deck

Take a few moments, breathe deeply, attune to the celestial forces, focus on your question and choose your cards. Feel the meaning that comes through you. Do not feel constrained by the description, if it does not feel applicable.

Bring your readings to life...

The Goddess and God energies are much like dream figures. To deepen your connection to them, view them as live beings. When any of the guides show up in your reading, visualize them 3 dimensionally. Watch them breathe, walk, blink their eyes. How do they smell? How do they hold space in the room? How do you feel around them? How do they react to you? Speak to them and listen for a reply. The interaction is more meaningful if you see their aliveness. You may call any of them, at any time for further interaction and relationship deepening.

You may also enrich your experience by inviting the Gods and Goddesses into your dreamtime. Watch for synchronicities, people and events that carry the 'energy' or lessons of the god or goddesses you draw, may show up as humans in waking life. When this happens, pay particular attention to what evolves. When you find the images crossing over into other parts of your life, it affirms your 'knowing' and amplifies the experience.

This deck is meant to enhance your insight, always attune to your own common sense and intuition when reading.

Relax and enjoy... the journey.

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0. The Jester—Baubo

Upright:

When Baubo shows up in your cards get ready to laugh! This little being brings the absurd, unexpected and ridiculous! She gives the ability to look at situations differently. If you are feeling stuck, depressed, or just weary, Baubo is the anti-dote. Spend a little time appreciating the silly, funny and slightly obscene. Get out of your rut and clear your head. Let Baubo lead the way. The Jester energy breaks up stagnation with lightness and laughter, adding her unique touch of unconventional brilliance to each moment. Baubo also reminds us that parts of us we are self-conscious about may in time, become our biggest treasures.

Reversed:

Are you experiencing an artistic block?

It is time to meet Baubo! She is talented at shaking away stagnation and depression. If you are not having much fun lately, do something to make yourself grin. Do it now! Do not underestimate the power of goofy.

It is so easy to become grim and take one's self very seriously. Laughing at yourself occasionally makes a good healing practice. Baubo in the cards is telling you it is time to shake it up with humor. Baubo loves spontaneity. It is playtime!

1. The Magician—Hermes



Upright:

Time spent with Hermes is always entertaining. When he shows up in your cards something interesting is about to happen. Hermes loves excitement, action and change. He is versatile and teaches you how to adjust to various situations and places. Hermes encourages you to put time into travelling, marketing and sales. He is charming and eloquent and brings talents in writing and speaking.

How can you apply his versatility, ability to communicate and people skills into your personal and business life? Hermes is an alchemist and knows what ingredients to use when creating potions, group dynamics and ideas. It's not just about what you have, but how you blend it! How can you artfully combine what is already yours, to create something fresh and relevant?

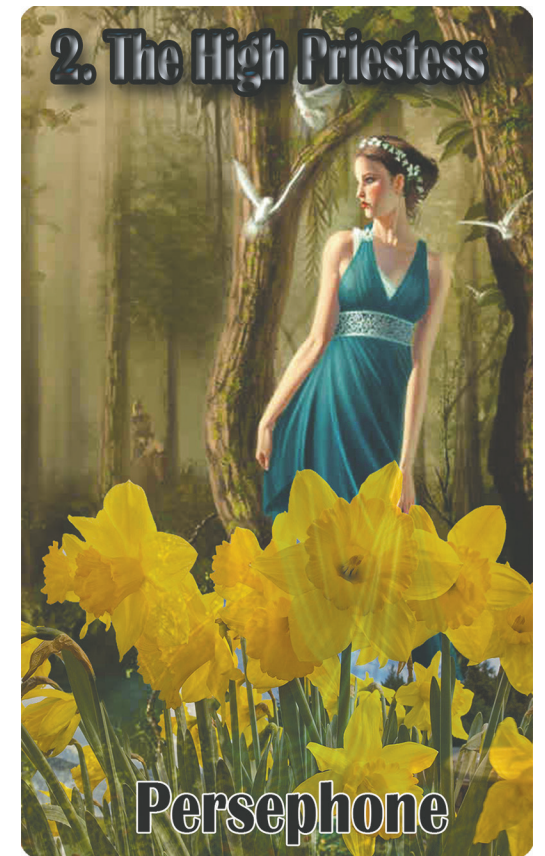
Hermes also brings newness and change. What fresh ideas are bursting through you?

Reversed:

Hermes can be both bluntly honest and purposely deceptive. Has he left you confused? Look to actions, not words to see the truth. Do not be fooled by charm; it is a magician's trick. Hermes ego is fragile and he gets a little mean when confronted or snubbed. He may also meddle, gossip and create mischief. The best way back from Hermes's fun, but short ride is through your heart. Get in touch with what matters, not what sounds best. Own your part in the deception. Was there a small part of you that enjoyed travelling with the magic man? Keep your inner magician alive by learning from his ingenuity and flexibility. Apply these skills to your personal magic bag.

2. The High Priestess—Persephone



Upright:

When Persephone enters your cards, you know you are in the realm of inspiration. Persephone is imaginative and mystical. She manifests potions, visions, hopes and new dimensions. Like her mentor Hekate, Persephone is able to cross thresholds. She is comfortable in both the inky recesses of the underworld and the stark brightness of the upperworld. When Persephone is in your life, you are able to see in the dark. Nothing enduring is made without incorporating two strands, one of shadows and one of illumination. True originality requires both ends of the spectrum to unfold. Persephone also brings deep insights. She understands how your thoughts and feelings pave your life path. She comes to you in dream state and visions to pass her knowledge on. Attune to her nightly updates to see the unique knowledge the High Priestess gives to you.

Reversed:

If you are in a creative slump feed your inner high priestess. She is nourished by myths, colors, beautiful surroundings and being attentive to your dreams. Do not discount the synchronicities and magic that show up in your daily life. This is how she manifests. Sometimes Persephone's insights follow a depression. What you learn from these dark, inner voyages can be life-changing revelations. Learn to harvest the insight from your descent. Dealing with Persephone takes tolerance for ambiguity. Write down what you remember and learn before it fades. Part of Persephone's shadow reveals a self-destructive streak. When on a journey with Persephone, balance the needs of your inner mystic with staying grounded. On Persephone's watch, it can be hard to maintain daily life. Yet, the high priestess needs you to keep both your body and spiritual life nourished.

3. The Empress—Hera



Upright:

When the Queen of Heavens graces you with her presence she is granting you the gift of partnership and devotion. She is a phenomenal spouse and values deep, respectful relationships. Hera is monogamous and keeps her promises, even when it is inconvenient. She is able to be strong and supportive at the same time. She is reminding you to count your blessings and be grateful for the intimate partnership you have. No spouse is perfect, but remember why you fell in love with yours. What special gifts do they bring? If you are single, Hera may bring a potential mate your way. Enjoy the sensuality and luxury of your life. Hera respects those who live up to their promises. Make your word gold.

Reversed:

Hera is a devoted wife, but betrayals have left her angry, vengeful and bitter.

Is there anywhere in your life you are feeling betrayed? Are you seething and unable to let go of your resentment? If so, confront the one who cheated on you. If you wish to stay with them, you will need to forgive. If you cannot forgive, do not stay. If you are choosing a mate, look for someone whose loyalty, devotion and commitment equal your own. Do not squash your own significant power for the idea of a relationship. Be sure the person is deserving of the many gifts you offer. Honor time you spend with yourself. You are a person of means and integrity. Keep your commitment for another in reserve, until you know they are worthy.

4. The Emperor—Zeus



Upright:

When Zeus shows up in your cards, you are holding a royal hand. The King of Gods is surging with currents of power and experience. Zeus brings optimism, lust for life and lots of energy. He lets you know you can accomplish anything! What is your desire? He creates new ideas and projects through his positive interactions. Zeus brings abundance, good fortune and manifestation. If you want to establish a business or endeavor, this is the time. Zeus is a dynamic administrator. If you wish to increase your competence and status, his charisma is an undeniable asset. Zeus is a strong and magnetic force. Tap into your own allure and draw in, what is of great benefit for all aspects of your life.

Reversed:

Are you acting like a dictator in any way? If you want to hear the truth from others, then, do not punish them when they tell it to you. Zeus brings plenty of charm and potential. Whatever he touches is changed by his power. The bolt of lightning can be fodder for destruction or brilliant manifestation. Practice being mindful about what you focus on. With great power, comes great responsibility. How will your actions affect the lives of others? Use your influence wisely. Ensure your thoughts and actions create a positive outcome for all.

5. The Healer—Asclepius



Upright:

When Asclepius shows up in your reading you are being given the opportunity to heal. Your body is skilled at maintaining stasis and repairing itself. If you attune, or meditate, it will tell you what to do. Celebrate in your body's brilliance. Asclepius also heals others. You may be asked to give your time and attention to help another while they are vulnerable. This son of Apollo accomplished great medical feats. His staff, a snake symbolizes deep regeneration and medical excellence. Asclepius in your cards brings you, your own miracle. Align with your higher good and wish for something powerful!

Reversed:

You may be asked to take time and decipher the message your body is giving you. What does it need? What do you require on an emotional, mental and spiritual level? How do you align your body and mind so they can work together more harmoniously? Asclepius reversed may be reminding you to attend to the balance in your life. Are you ignoring or misusing your innate power to heal? Are you doing what you really want in life? Are you doing what you are meant to do? Setbacks are a way of pressing the reset button in the psyche providing another chance to align with what you want at your core. You are being given precious knowledge, at one time considered forbidden. Ensure you use it for the highest good. If you are caretaking another, who is sick, it may feel like a burden, but you have the power to make that time into a healing and transforming experience, for all parties involved.

6. The Lovers—Aphrodite

Upright:

When Aphrodite enters your life, take time to smell the roses. Her message is to play more and worry less. She brings gifts of beauty and pleasure, which give life texture and meaning. Breathe in her intoxicating, floral bouquet and allow her to transform drudgery to ease. Open your senses and smell, taste, touch, hear and see all the abundance around you. Aphrodite blesses you with love, happiness and laughter. Her presence helps you awaken to what is precious. Aphrodite teaches you to be thankful for your many gifts. She knows how to romance the moment and sparks your enthusiasm for life. If you are single, the Lovers card indicates romance is brewing. If you are married, she reminds you to take the time to listen to and appreciate your mate.

Reversed:

Are you making good choices in your love life? Do the people in your life let you be yourself? Do you feel appreciated for who you are? Do you do enough of what gives you bliss and joy? If not, how can you?

On the other hand, are you over indulging and ignoring your responsibilities? Are you respecting the needs of others? Are you being truthful in difficult situations?

Aphrodite teaches you that your life is a series of potentially amazing moments. You will never have this exact experience again. You are the powerful creator of your life. It is important to balance work, play, truth and kindness.

Be cognizant of how your choices create your life. The creative palette Aphrodite offers is comprised of beauty, sensuality, enjoyment, romance and gratitude. Do not rush through her lessons of love. They are precious and sweet.

7. The Chariot—Achilles



Upright:

When you receive Achilles in an upright position you are being gifted with energy, focus and willpower. Achilles brings hope, heroic effort and momentum.

You have strength, purpose and strategic ability. You are able to work hard and accomplish much. You may be asked to help with social causes. It is a good time to step up and defend others. It is the time to move your projects, ideas and life forward. The Chariot gives you much ability to manifest. This will be true with your physical, emotional and spiritual energy, as long as it is aligned with your highest purpose. You are brave and loyal, but not invulnerable. Balance is still vital. Pay attention to the needs of your body and messages from those around you. Tap into your

wisdom to know when to engage and when to regenerate. How do you wish to use your drive to move your life forward, now?

Reversed:

A reversed Achilles suggests it is time to realistically assess where you are vulnerable. Which part of your body and emotions is sending you messages to slow down and pay attention? What is your body telling you? How can you help to heal yourself? This is the time to tend to a wounded part of your life. Caring for yourself now will allow you to resume later, with even more wisdom and purpose. The Achilles card advises you to use your power wisely. Think things through and act with purpose and heart, not vengeance or anger. If you are blinded by love or rage, it could have negative effects. Be careful to not allow negative impulses to override your wiser knowing. You have plenty of drive and momentum, but focus your wisdom before moving in any direction to avoid setbacks.

8. Strength—Psyche



Upright:

The type of strength held by Psyche is not always exalted. Yet, without the hard earned talents of discretion, persistence and patience we are unable to make our lives shine in an enduring way. None of these skills is easily developed. They require practicing tasks and attitudes that are difficult to cultivate. Yet, when Psyche shows up in your cards she is asking you, "how badly do you want, what you say you want"? For Psyche, the prize was winning back the love of her husband Eros.

The ordeal she needed to accomplish turned her into a woman of substance and skill. So when you are faced with tasks that seem boring or difficult, ask, "how are they developing the deeper aspects of your character?" Stick to worthy pursuits to become a person of integrity. True love of course, is always your finest strength.

Reversed:

Part of discretion is determining if what you are doing will serve a greater purpose, or teach you worthy skills. Are you making good choices in your life? Are your choices leading you to where you wish to be? Do you keep your eye on your goal, or get off track and forget your purpose? Psyche reminds you to keep a clear head about what you are doing and why you are doing it. Are you persistent enough, or do you give up easily? If your goals and schedule accomplish what is of value to you, they are worthy.

What gives you strength and purpose? Feed this part of yourself. Do not forget to celebrate your successes. Accomplishment will feel satisfying, if it meets needs that are real and meaningful. Success will feel hollow if the original goal was someone else's, or not of true importance to you. It takes patience and persistence to face your fear and accomplish goals. This takes strength- so does love.

9. The Hermit—Hephasteus



Upright:

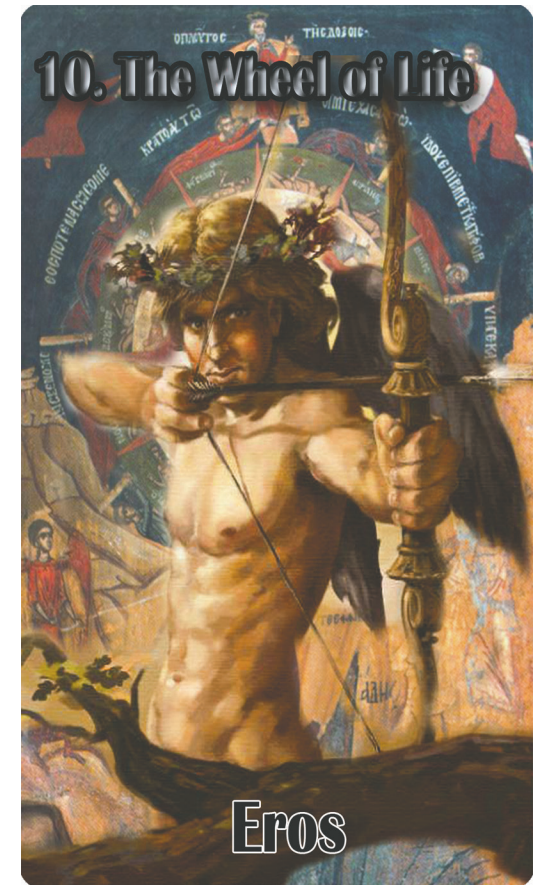
Hephasteus teaches you to accept yourself, warts, wounds and beauty. This is not a task that comes easily for most of us. You can knock yourself out trying to please someone who does not really 'get' you, but it won't help, if you are not who they love. Someone will always find reasons to reject or find fault. Yet, it is by daring to be yourself, that your own unique brilliance is honed. Sometimes you need to be alone for extensive periods to get to know and appreciate yourself. You need time and training to develop skills that allow you to bring your gifts into the light and claim your own power. Hephasteus grants you time alone. He also brings artistic skills and intelligence. What are the gifts you are forging from your disappointments and upsets? How are you turning them into amazing assets?

Reversed:

It hurts when someone you love does not love you back, or see your strengths. It is crippling to be rejected and ignored. Yet, in order to develop a sense of self, you need to love even your wounds and less than perfect pieces. Seeing and accepting, your damaged parts develops character and depth. It makes you whole and unstoppable. If you do not take the time to turn self-hate into love, you will be perpetually bitter and angry. Learning to forgive those who have hurt you with their rejection and indifference, grants you freedom. Take time alone to restore perspective and sanity.

10. The Wheel of Life—Eros



Upright:

When Eros comes knocking it is time to put on your finest attire and open the door. Eros brings passion. The zeal may be for a person, an idea or a lifestyle. Even though, a visit by Eros is often unexpected, it will ignite something new and lead you in a fun and provocative direction. The arrows of Eros are special. They change perspective and open up new fortune. By following your heart, new pieces of yourself blossom, as do new opportunities. Eros also teaches wisdom about surviving the ride on the wheel of life. Every position has up and down points. Learn to love where you are. Being in the present moment allows enjoyment and acceptance. Fighting the ride is natural initially, but continuous resistance creates an anxious journey.

Reversed:

It is important to pursue love, with clarity, not naivety. Sometimes, it is a short ride that does not last. If you have had a bad experience, know that the wound created by Eros's arrow, will hold the medicine. There will be much to learn and understand from meditating on the experience. Regardless of where Eros takes you, you need to come back to yourself, and direct real love and empathy in your own direction. Eros teaches the only place to be on the wheel of fortune is 'where you are currently at'. Wishing to be somewhere else, with someone else creates anxiety and dissatisfaction. Make your life choices wisely then realize every ride has high points and bumps. If you are in a committed relationship avoid being fickle. Even if your indiscretion is not exposed, you cheapen your relationship with thoughtless actions. However, a little objectivity and humor is a valuable asset on the ever-changing wheel of life.

11. Justice—Athena



Upright:

When Athena shows up in your life know you are in the hands of a great mentor. The Goddess of Justice wants you to define your goals. She is an academic and encourages you to get the education you need to excel. Get clear on what your talents and interests are and determine how to use them in the workforce. She is also fiercely independent economically and may suggest you find a business or career that is relatively lucrative. She is inventive and practical. No matter what your situation, she knows you can shine and encourages you to work both hard and smart. She will help steer you in the direction of making strategic business decisions. She brings great ability to be resourceful and clever. Athena also solidifies your relationship to older males, such as your father. She

is loyal a good negotiator and has strong decision making ability. Athena is very fair and brings justice into her personal and professional life. How are you able to create equitable relationships in your situation?

Reversed:

It may be time to get out of your head and pay attention to your heart. Have you been armored in your relationships, lately? Is there an issue of trust going on? If so, get clear on what you want. Athena reversed insists you think strategically about your business and career. A good plan and consistent implementation aids success. Performance is rewarded when the student learns how to master a subject. This takes patience, practice and humility. Showing proper respect and loyalty toward your mentors creates good relationships and future dealings. If you are financially, self-sufficient consider helping those in need of economic and skill based resources. Athena may bring material reward, and recognition, but she insists you work ethically. Athena is not a cuddly goddess. She brings fairness and justice. If you have been cutting corners, it is time to stop and make amends.

12. The Paradox—Pan



Upright:

When Pan shows up in your cards it is time to take a walk on the wild side. Sometimes perspectives need to change. Pan knows how to take you out of your comfort zone and introduce a little feral blood into your veins. The old goat is charismatic and unconventional. He is drawn to inner paradoxes. Where are you saying one thing and doing another? Becoming uptight when too much is expected of you and bowing to social convention can cause damage. Sometimes you just have to say what you really want, rather than pretending. Evading a confrontation will cause ripples of reaction to become waves of anger, if not dealt with. Pan does believe in right and wrong, but in an organic approach, not predicated by conventional norms. So if you are feeling too constrained, this wild card may help you find freedom through the unusual. Pan is also giving you an invitation to explore the world of nature. It can wake you up and give you perspective.

Reversed:

Have you been in a rut and unwilling to try something new? Pan suggests it is time to start seeing what is fresh and magical. That does not mean the routine you have been following is not worthy, but maybe you have stopped being appreciative. Falling asleep in your life is akin to death. So, wake up and evaluate what needs to shift. As a wise man once said, “you can change two things in your life, your situation or your attitude. Both choices are indeed powerful.

Get congruent. If you have been living a lie, it is time to admit the truth and take the consequences. Pan is not a fan of hypocrisy. A trip to his temple, nature, will help you clear the cobwebs and prioritize what is important.

13. The Crossroads—Hekate



Upright:

When Hekate shows up in your cards it is time to close a chapter of your life. Ask yourself truthfully, 'what no longer serves me'? Nature knows how to prune off what is no longer vital. When an apple tree has too many small apples to effectively support, it sheds some. If it did not, the tree itself, and all of its other baby apples would die. We feel dead or stuck when we refuse to make choices that are uncomfortable. Is there a choice you need to make that you are avoiding? There is no perfect path. All choices at the crossroads carry risks and have a price. Indecision is a type of purgatory and staleness is the price. Hekate can give you the tools to see your options. Choose with your heart and instinct intact and move forward. After the deed is done, or over, letting go of what you tried so hard to hang on to can actually feel like a relief.

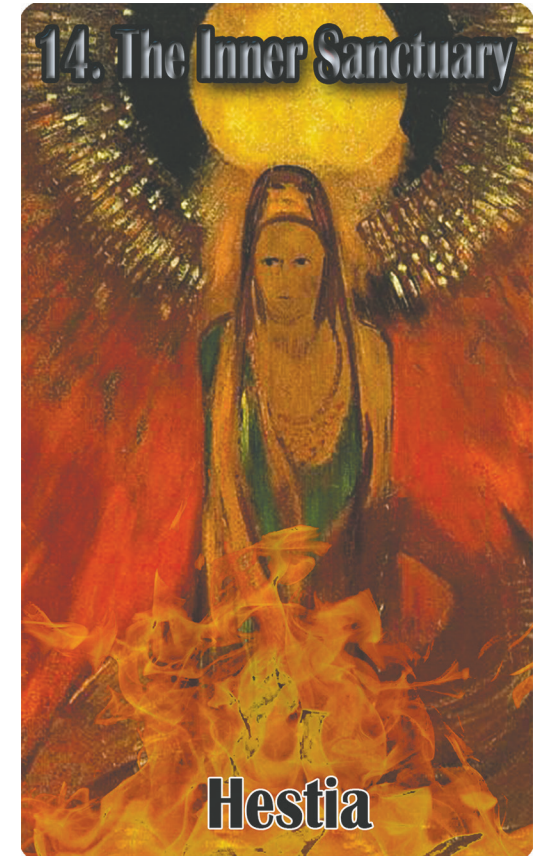
Reversed:

Hekate gives you the opportunity to be truthful about what and whom you need in your life, to meet your soul purpose. You cannot move on to a new chapter, until you close an old one. When you do not willingly make decisions, sometimes fate will do it for you. Old situations and relationships may dissolve or explode or illness or disaster may occur. There is a non-negotiable quality about Hekate. Nevertheless, she is also a teacher of great power.

When you no longer belong in one realm, she can show you how to navigate the next. All things change and many cannot be controlled. She teaches you to allow in a new cycle, and see the gifts that it brings. No matter where your journey, Hekate makes an unparalleled mentor, who guides the way.

14. The Inner Sanctuary—Hestia



Upright:

Hestia, goddess of the hearth is showing up to boost your self-worth. This guide brings the ability to find what you need inside of yourself. She teaches you to tend your inner sanctuary. What is it that truly excites you? What makes the light shine brighter in your eyes? This passion is the one to feed and nourish. Do not get side tracked by lesser desires that only consume you. She teaches balance, good judgment and how to keep the inner temple sacred. Hestia likes to go slow. She is strong enough to know her deliberate rhythm, is important and nurturing. Hestia sees the good in others, even when society forgets them. Her belief in people helps free them from addictions, and self sabotage. Hestia carries true kindness and hospitality. Hestia quietly respects her own self worth, and the worth of others.

Reversed:

Hestia shows you that you are the creator of your own life, from the tiniest thought to the largest action. You hold incredible power! The keys are to keep your inner fire burning and tend to your inner cycles.

Learning to see where you are in the season of your soul leads you toward deeper understanding, of your own growth process. There are times when you are in winter mode. You are hibernating and regenerating. Trying to disrupt your slumber pattern at this time would only stunt your growth. Hestia teaches you patience. Certain things cannot be rushed. Hestia also carries the Olympian Flame to remind you of your significance. At times, you feel invisible, as if your talents and contributions are not seen or appreciated. Learn to take this matter into your own hands. Witness your own accomplishments and feel your worth, fully, quietly and internally. This is a super power few people attain. You are no longer at the mercy of others to validate you.

15.—The Underworld Hades



Upright:

When Hades appears in a reading pay close attention to your senses. Is there something that you are not noticing that you need to focus on? Is anything too good to be true? Hades can be a part of ourselves that self sabotages. Hades can also be an outer force that negates or harms your creative life and soul purpose.

There are three major reasons we do not confront Hades:

1. We do not see his mischief, as our senses are not developed to detect what is awry.
2. We comply with the self-destructive energy, because it in some way makes our life easier, or pleases our ego.
3. We are scared and do not know what to do to stop this force.

When Hades enters your cards, it is time to wake up, determine what is challenging your growth and put an end to his power.

Reversed:

Hades has tricked us and taken away something we love. The Hades force is often a piece of us that does not believe we are worthy. This inner force will then cause us to behave, as if its negative voice is true. For example, even if we are prepared for an important meeting we get sick before it happens, and lose an opportunity. Hades may also manifest as an outer adversary, such as, a deal, we strike with our boss, at work. We agree to work more time for more money. We become successful financially, but our personal life becomes flat and feels less meaningful. When Hades arrives, it is important to figure out his sabotage, where he hides and how to stop him. You are wise enough to see his tricks. Pay attention and stop the destruction!

16.—The Tower Medusa



Upright:

When Medusa shows up in your cards keep alert. It is very easy to be blamed and rejected when others do not understand you, or your situation. You may have been held responsible for someone else's mistake or convicted for acts you did not carry out. Try not to get defensive and escalate the discord. However, do not fall victim to unfair accusations. Remember, Medusa is a target because she has great capacity. What is your power? Sometimes we are victim to other's prejudice and meanness. Nevertheless, the person who lives through such bias and turns it into understanding, becomes powerful indeed! It does not hurt to take a glimpse at why you have such a strong impact on others. Gain some insight about group dynamics, but do not give up your unique identity. Looking into a mirror can be uncomfortable, but insightful. Turn your objective insights into growth.

Upright:

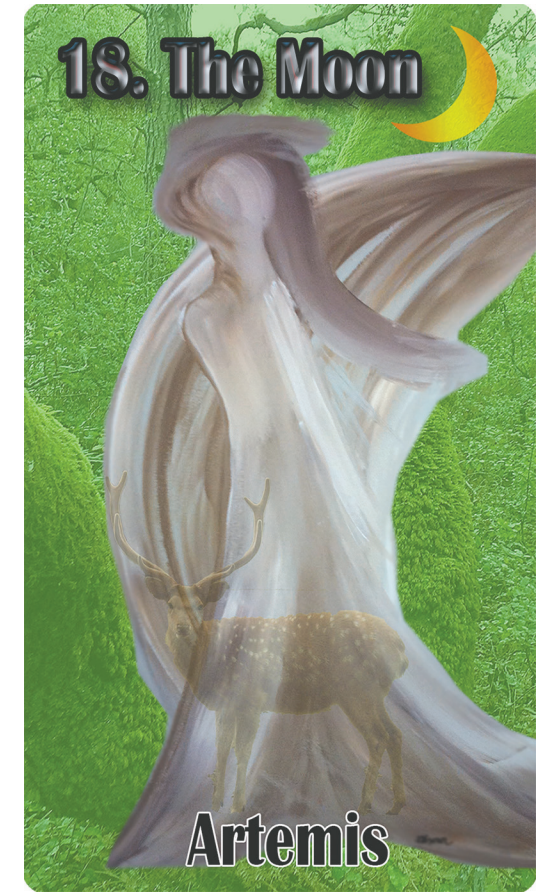

Upright:

Upright:

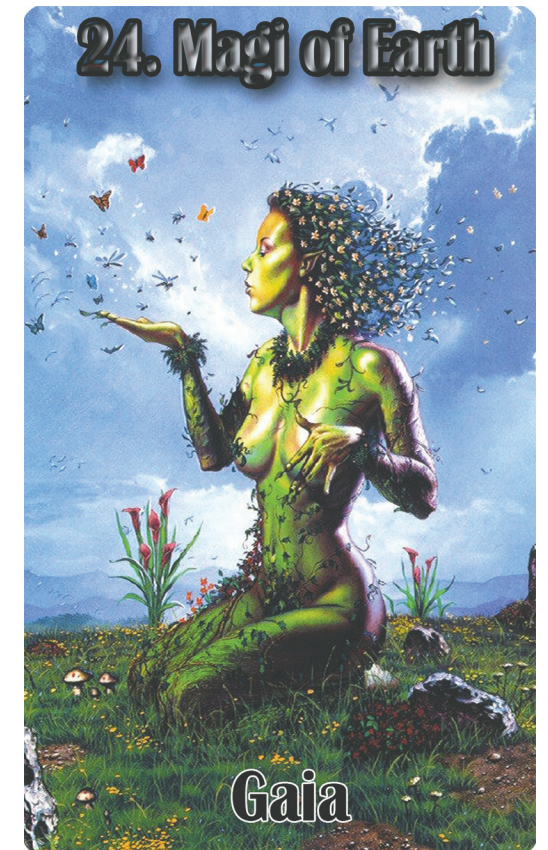
