Aromatic Pleasure Kit Assignment

Find someone to work with who loves essential oils. This may be a family member, friend, or associate.

Use your questionnaire and observational abilities to help determine their sensitivities and allergies. Ensure they understand the cautions about essential oils.

Do not use with children under 3.

Ensure the client is not sensitive or allergic to the oil.

Use only the safer essential oils, no oral use.

Do not use with anyone pregnant, allergic or otherwise sensitive, be it people or animals.

Determine which essential oils and carriers will work for the simple products you create. Create the products for them.

Purpose: Tying it all together. You have made some of these products for yourself already. Now is the time to refine them and make them for someone else. Ensure you have good bottles, oils and supplies. Be sure to label all of your products, with an indelible pen. Include written instructions for all products so they know how to use them.

Interview your client to determine their preferences. Set up a plan to give them simple aromatic tools for their daily life. Since you have not yet done the classes on blending and cream creation, (again content in aroma advanced), stick with blending your singular oil into commercial creams, lotions, shower gels. Check out an aromatic store near you for lovely ready-made mediums to blend in, or just add the oil into product that you already use.

The purpose of this exercise is to provide experience in creating product for clients and to bring aromatherapy into your daily life to make certain moments more rhythmic, healing and pleasant.

For each product check your course to determine which singular oil to use for each product.

For each product specify the proportions of essential oil, to water, or to carrier oil, (or other mediums). You can find information on proportions in your course introduction or on the web.

Provide written instructions on how to apply- (on skin, in a diffuser, in the bath, etc.).

Justify why you chose each ingredient- I.e. All three oils chosen for diffusing in the car increase mental alertness and are therefore suitable for the purpose of good driving. Include any Cautions related to the essential oils or carrier oils in your blend.

Articulate your client's situation- "Mary drives within the city where much alertness is required".

Let me in on your client's preference from the oils you suggest. Mary prefers lemon out of the 3 essential oils, (rosemary, peppermint and lemon) that I suggested were good for increasing alertness, while she drove.
